
# Do It Yourself Pasta Drying Rack English Dimensions




#### Materials

- 1" x 2" x 12' pine, oak or other wood species
- 5/8" diameter x 3' long rod
- 3/8" diameter x 10' long rod
- Carpenter's glue (optional)
- Oil stain (optional)
- Provides up to 9 feet of drying area.


- Rack Feet
  - Quantity 2
  - Make using 1" x 2"



- Lower Brace
  - Make using 1" x 2"




- Upper Brace
  - Make using 1" x 2"
  - Match drill holes using Lower Brace




BOTTOM VIEW SCALE: NONE

- Upper Brace
  - Front Hole Pattern



FRONT VIEW SCALE: NONE

- Vertical Rods
  - Quantity 2
  - Make Using 5/8" DIA Rod



- Pasta Drying Rods
  - Quantity: 12
  - Make Using 3/8" DIA Rod



- Rack can made to be:
  - Completely disassemble for storage
  - Or the drying rods can be permanently glued to the Upper Brace using carpenter's glue
